Greg was a top ranked junior tennis player in New Zealand. He played his collegiate tennis at Fresno State playing #1 singles and doubles. He transferred to Baylor University for his Senior year, in which his team was ranked #1 in the country and went 33-1, losing in the NCAA Division I final. Internationally, Greg played 4 seasons of professional club tennis in Germany and many international junior tournaments. After graduating from Baylor with a Masters Degree in Sports Management, Greg traveled with several top 150 WTA players and top 50 ITF juniors. He comes to Eagle Fustar after working the last two years at Weil Tennis academy where he trained and traveled with their Junior ITF team.

The Eagle Fustar Full Time Program is based at the tennis center on the Santa Clara University Campus, and trains all week from 8:30-2:00pm with daily fitness sessions from 2-3pm. In addition to the Full Time Program, Eagle Fustar offers training clinics seven days per week at three locations in the Bay Area for beginners through advanced juniors.
